



## Environmental policy ArcelorMittal Gent, Geel and Genk

ArcelorMittal Gent develops, produces and delivers to its customers flat carbon steel in numerous qualities, either coated or uncoated, and by-products that result from the steel making process. This is done with great care for the environment, both during the production itself as during the full life cycle of the end products.

The use of steel should be promoted as steel distinguishes itself from other materials by its suitability for recycling and therefore it contributes to a sustainable use of raw materials.

The following principles have been integrated in all activities and guaranteed by the application of an environmental management system in accordance with the international ISO 14001 standard:

- 1. Sustainable development, which guarantees a continuous balance between environmental, economic and social interests;**
- 2. Continuous improvement of environmental performances by taking permanent care of the environment and preventing as much as possible any ecological nuisance or adverse effects;**
- 3. The development, application and improvement of production methods with the least environmental impact possible;**
- 4. The development and manufacturing of products that show good environmental characteristics during their entire life cycle, together with our customers and suppliers;**
- 5. The efficient use of natural sources and energy and minimise our carbon footprint where technically and economically feasible;**
- 6. The commitment of all employees, and of the management in particular, to produce steel in an environment-friendly manner and to comply with all legal obligations and to observe all other commitments made by the organisation;**
- 7. Encouragement of employees, contractors and suppliers to an environment-friendly attitude through information and training;**
